- Table Caption: Font- 10", lower case and Top of the table, position-center
- Paragraph: Paragraph Indentation by- 0.2" Line Spacing: single
- Before: 0" After: 0" Header 0.3" footer 0"

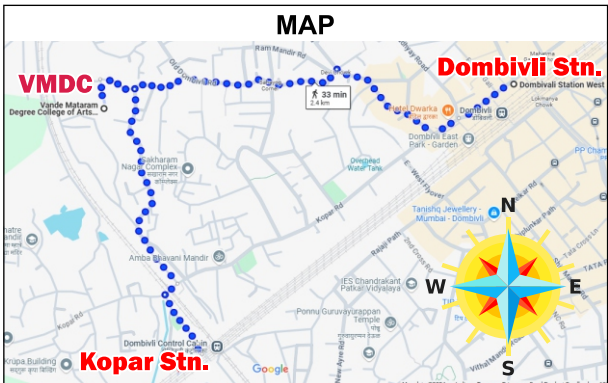
Presentation Details
